

## Lead in

Show your students pictures of daily household chores and ask them to discuss the following questions.

*How do you feel about household chores?*

*Which chores you can't stand doing?*

*How much time do you spend on housework?*

Make sure the students can name the daily chores they see.



## Feedback

Now, show them a picture of Queen Elizabeth and ask them to discuss the following questions.

*How much time does Queen Elizabeth spend on housework? Why?*



## Introduction to the target language

Write the following examples on the board

1. Queen Elizabeth **is having/is getting *her meal prepared*** by a two-star Michelin chef.
  2. Queen Elizabeth **will have *a qualified gardener manicure*** the gardens at Buckingham Palace
  3. Queen Elizabeth **got *her footmen to polish*** the silverware at Buckingham Palace
- *Did the Queen perform any of the above?*
  - *Who did all these household chores for her?*

Match structures **a-c** to sentences **1-3**

- a) have/get sth done
- b) get sb to do sth
- c) have sb do sth

- *When can we use these structures?*
- *Compare and contrast the three.*

*All three of them are examples of Causative and they are used to indicate that somebody does something on behalf of sb else.*

*The verb forms can be at any tense depending on what we want to say.*

- a) **have/get + object + past participle** - *If we want to mention who performs the action we can add (by +agent)*
- b) **get + sb** *(the person who performs the action on sb else's behalf)+ full infinitive*
- c) **have + sb** *(the person who performs the action on sb else's behalf)+ bare infinitive*
